23-28 September 2024 Nosy Be Island, Madagascar

ITINERARY

Day 1 — 23 September: Arrival in Antananarivo (Dinner)

A member of the ASISTEN Travel team, an award winning Madagascar tour operator and Destination Management Company, will welcome you and participants taking the Southern Madagascar tour in the international arrivals hall at Ivato International Airport, Antananarivo. Look out for a sign with your name after you exit the restricted area with your luggage. You will then be led to your vehicle for your private transfer to the Radisson Blu Antananarivo Waterfront Hotel where you can relax or explore the nearby attractions.

Dinner and overnight at the Radisson Blu Antananarivo Waterfront Hotel.



Day 2 — 24 September: Antananarivo and Nosy Be (Breakfast and Dinner)

Breakfast at the hotel and then meet your guide at 08:00 in the lobby.

The day will start with a visit to Antananarivo's central business district (CBD) and downtown. You will visit the city's main CBD and administrative neighbourhoods, which spread out from the city's railroad station at Soarano, the Avenue of Independence and the place of the 'Zoma' (Friday market), the largest open air market in the world. You will have the opportunity to climb one of the many stairways called 'totobato" which will lead you to the CBD, the street of jewellers and the presidential palace.

At 14:00 you will be transferred to the Ivato International Airport for your domestic flight to Nosy Be.

A member of the Asisten team will welcome you at Fascene International Airport. Lookout for a sign with your name after you exit the restricted area with your luggage. You will then be led to your vehicle for a private transfer to the Palm Beach Resort and Spa. Enjoy a warm welcome with music by local musicians, a coconut drink and cold towels as you check in.

Dinner and overnight at the Palm Beach Resort.



Day 3 — 25 September: Lokobe Reserve (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner)

Breakfast at the resort and then meet your guide at 08:00 in the lobby.

Lokobe Reserve. We will leave the hotel and go to the harbour to take a speedboat towards Lokobe which covers around 740 hectares and includes the last remaining lowland rainforest found on Nosy Be island. The reserve is known for the black lemur and there are other nocturnal species such as the gray-backed sportive lemur and some mouse lemurs. Lokobe is also home to some endemic birds like the Madagascar pygmy kingfisher or the Madagascar long-eared owl as well as spectacular panther-chameleons, local endemic frogs and several snakes. We will have a walk in the reserve to spot some wildlife. Lunch will be taken on Nosy Komba, an authentic small island. Time for relaxing will be available before returning to your resort.

Dinner and overnight at the Palm Beach Resort.



Day 4 — 26 September: Nosy Be (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner)

Breakfast at the resort and then meet your guide at 08:00 in the lobby.

Nosy Komba and Nosy Tanikely excursion. This day is devoted to an excursion to the islands of Nosy Tanikely and Nosy Komba. Nosy Tanikely is a small island which is part of the Nosy Be archipelago. This inhabited island is a marine reserve and offers one of the most impressive snorkeling experiences. It's an open air aquarium. Surrounded by some coral reefs, the undersea biodiversity is very rich and you may even have the chance to spot some sea turtles while you are snorkeling.

We will continue to Nosy Komba reserve to have a close up experience with the *Eulemur macaco* or black lemur. First of all, however, we will have lunch at a local restaurant. Then we will discover several species of endemic reptiles including the colourful chameleons and turtles. For the more adventurous, you may have a chance to meet the Madagascar ground boa *madagascariensis*, a species of the Boidae (boa) family, which is endemic to the island of Madagascar. A short walk will take you through a small village and a great handcraft market.

Dinner and overnight at the Palm Beach Resort.

Day 5 — 27 September: Lemuria Land (Breakfast and Dinner)

Breakfast at the resort and then meet your guide at 08:00 in the lobby.

Lemuria Land. Today we will be going to Lemuria Land: a natural and botanical reserve full of centenarian ylang ylang trees which are famous on the island of Nosy Be. The tour will take you on a discovery of the endemic wildlife of Madagascar, not only a large variety of endemic lemurs, but also reptiles: the finest specimens of chameleons, crocodiles, various species of turtles and lizards. Then we go to a traditional hut in the region that is called "kaz butterflies" where you will discover a static display of insects and beautiful butterflies of Madagascar. With a bit of luck, you will also witness the arrival of the collection trucks loaded with ylang ylang flowers, or perhaps you will see the release of essential oils from the still following extraction from the flowers.

Dinner and overnight at the Palm Beach Resort.

Day 6 — 28 September: End of the Package (Breakfast)

Breakfast at the resort.

Transfer to the Fascene International Airport for your departure flight.
